Arizona Theatre Company is the state's only LORT theatre, as well as the only LORT theatre in the country that produces in two cities-Tucson and Phoenix Metropolitan Area. Under the leadership of Kasser Family Artistic Director Matt August, ATC produces 5-6 mainstage shows, various workshops and galas each year. Shows are built, rehearsed, and opened in Tucson at the Temple of Music and Art, and then move to the Phoenix Metro Area at our new home at the Tempe Center for the Arts.

Overview

The Tempe Light Board Operator works with the Lighting & Projections Supervisor as the lighting console operator to maintain the integrity of each production in Tempe.

Essential Functions

- Primarily responsible for the operation and maintenance of all lighting equipment for ATC productions in Tempe.
- •Assist the Lighting & Projections Supervisor in the execution of each production design as needed, as well as supporting and facilitating the needs of guest designers.
- Maintain the integrity of the design as finalized by the Lighting Designer.
- Hang, set-up and strike equipment during load-in and load out for Tempe. This includes patching and testing conventional and intelligent lights.
- Supervise overhire crews during load-in and load-out as directed by the Lighting & Projections Supervisor.
- Conduct regular maintenance on lighting equipment as directed by the Lighting & Projections Supervisor.
- •Assist in the preparation, set up and/or installation of lighting-related production elements as necessary for other special ATC events or outside rental events as requested by Production Management.
- Other duties as assigned.
